It is recommended that candidates possess a current National Water Hygiene qualification, which is mandatory to enter a clean water site. Additional training can be provided where required.

CSCS Affiliation

The Utility SHEA (Water) scheme is affiliated with the CSCS to allow water industry workers access to construction sites for purposes of utilities work without the need to complete a separate CSCS card.

CSCS affiliated cards carry the CSCS hologram in the top left corner. A coloured bar may also appear under this hologram denoting the level that the operative has achieved in line with the CSCS card colour scheme.
